Literacy

Create a leaflet for 'How to Survive the Bronze Age'. Imagine that you have been transported back to the Bronze Age at Flag Fen and need a guide to help you to survive. What tips would you include? Think about food, shelter, tools and travel.

Maths

Create a Venn diagram to show the similarities and differences between prehistoric life and life today.

Design & Technology

Use a variety of materials to design and make a model roundhouse or Bronze Age causeway.

Geography

Find out where the best places to build Bronze and Iron Age settlements were and why.

Literacy / Drama

Write a list of questions you would like to ask a prehistoric person. You could hot seat a member of the class in the role of a prehistoric person to give the answers.

Literacy / History

Create a news report for the discovery of the Bronze Age causeway at Flag Fen.

Literacy

Write your own visitor's guide to Flag Fen. You could include information about the Roman road, wooden log boats, Bronze Age causeway, mere, roundhouses and museum.

Art

Create your own piece of artwork using your favourite media to represent a scene of everyday life in prehistoric times. You could use the artwork in Flag Fen's Preservation Hall and replica causeway to give you some ideas.

Maths

Compare the lengths and heights of different prehistoric animals for example woolly mammoth, auroch, grey wolf, Soay sheep, Irish elk, eel, smilodon.
