

Flag Fen Stone Age Survival Activity Map

Literacy

Create a leaflet for 'How to Survive the Stone Age'. Imagine that you have been transported back to the Stone Age at Flag Fen and need a guide to help you to survive. What tips would you include? Think about food, shelter, tools and travel.

Maths

Create a Venn diagram to show the similarities and differences between life in the Stone Age and life today.

Design & Technology

Use a variety of materials to design and make a Stone Age shelter or monument.

History

Transform a bar of soap into the shape of a Stone Age flint tool by knapping. Use clay modelling tools or a blunt plastic knife to chip away flakes of soap. You could make the shape of a hand axe, arrow head or a spear head with this technique.

Literacy / Drama

Write a list of questions you would like to ask a Stone Age person. You could hot seat a member of the class in the role of a Stone Age person to give the answers.

Geography

Find out the location of some Neolithic settlements in Britain. What made these locations a good place for Stone Age people to build their settlements?

Maths

During the Palaeolithic, people created a counting system using tally marks. Using this system, write some calculations for a friend to solve.

Art

Scrunch a piece of brown paper and open it out to give you a rock like texture. Use this as a background to create your own piece of Stone Age artwork using your favourite media.

Maths

Compare the lengths and heights of different prehistoric animals for example woolly mammoth, auroch, grey wolf, Soay sheep, Irish elk, eel, smilodon.
